The Gullen Solar Farm is the proposed development of a 10 MW solar photovoltaic (PV) power plant to power approx. 3000 NSW homes annually. The project would be co-located with the existing Gullen Range Wind Farm approximately 16km south of Crookwell and 28km north west of Goulburn.

The community is invited to drop in, find out the latest about the proposed development and provide feedback. Members of the Project Team will be available to answer questions and discuss the project plans.

On the day, Gullen Solar Farm will sponsor a Crookwell Lions Club Fundraiser BBQ near the Crookwell IGA from 11:30am — 2pm. Please note that all proceeds from the BBQ go direct to the Lions Club.

A Development Application for the project has been assessed by Upper Lachlan Shire Council in April 2016. Council and the Joint Regional Planning Panel have requested additional information regarding the development which has been submitted to Council and will be available on the day.

Construction is proposed to commence on the project in August 2016.
